#### § 16-1. Commission created.

There shall hereafter be in existence the Civil Service Commission for the Borough of Delmont, created in accordance with the provisions of Section 1171 of the Borough Code, 53 P.S. § 46171 et seq., to review and consider appointment to, promotion within, suspension, removal or reduction in rank for employees of the Borough of Delmont Police Department.

## § 16-2. Membership; terms.

The Civil Service Commission for the Borough of Delmont shall hereafter consist of three Commissioners who shall be duly qualified and appointed by resolution of the Borough Council for initial terms of two, four and six years and thereafter for appointments of six-year terms.

## § 16-3. Promulgation of rules and regulations.

The Commission shall have the power to prescribe, amend and enforce rules and regulations for carrying into effect the provisions of the Borough Code as they relate to police departments and to maintain such records as may be required to properly undertake the duties of said Commission.

#### § 16-4. Compliance required.

In addition to compliance with the rules and regulations as the said Civil Service Commission may reasonably adopt, the Commissioners appointed by Council shall ensure compliance with the provisions of the Borough Code relating to Civil Service Commissions and their responsibilities, particularly Sections 1171 through and including 1195, 53 P.S. §§ 46171 through 46195, inclusive.
