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**§ 28-1. Purpose.**

The purpose of this chapter is to acknowledge various statutory ordinance-enacted agreements and/or contracts.

**§ 28-2. Legislative authority.**

Intermunicipal agreements are passed pursuant to the powers granted to the Borough of Delmont by 53 P.S. § 481 et seq., as amended,<sup>1</sup> for the purposes and for the reasons for each ordinance so designated hereinafter.

- A. Intermunicipal Agreement between the Township of Salem and the Borough of Delmont taking effect on April 20, 1989, pertaining to the application of the Borough of Delmont Police Force upon the premises located in the Township of Salem, but owned by the Borough of Delmont, known as the "Shield's Cultural and Historical Park," being a park within the Borough of Delmont's park system, containing 158.316 acres as more fully described as Tax Parcel No. 56-13-00-0-019 as set forth in Deed Book Volume 2357, page 411, effective date is ten years from the date of execution and enactment. See attached Agreement.<sup>2</sup>
- B. An Intermunicipal Agreement between the Township of Salem and the Borough of Delmont taking effect on June 12, 1990, pertaining to the provision of Mutual Aid Emergency Services pursuant to terms of the Agreement to correspond with the Township of Salem's Resolution No. 182. See attached Agreement.<sup>3</sup>
- C. An Intermunicipal Agreement between the Borough of Delmont and the Township of Washington taking effect on October 9, 1990, pertaining to the provision of Mutual Aid Emergency Services pursuant to the terms of the Agreement to correspond with the Agreement and ordinance enacted by the Township of Washington. See attached Agreement.<sup>4</sup>

- D. The Borough of Delmont has evidenced its intent to participate in the Municipal Drug Task Force Agreement coordinated by the office of the Attorney General for the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, and executes the Agreement which is attached hereto and made a part hereof pursuant to its terms and conditions. Said Agreement shall take effect on July 9, 1996, pertaining to the sharing of the Borough of Delmont's police persons, resources and other signatory municipal resources. Said Agreement is attached hereto and made a part hereof.<sup>5</sup> The Agreement enacted by Ordinance No. 93-2 taking effect on April 13, 1993, is hereby repealed.
- E. Agreement of Membership, authorizing membership by Delmont Borough in the Central Westmoreland Council of Governments and establishing the conditions of said membership pursuant to the requirements of Act 180 of 1972, 53 P.S. §§ 481-490, as amended.<sup>6</sup> The Agreement shall take effect May 11, 1999. See Attached Agreement.<sup>7</sup>
