Standard Pipe Services LLC, under contract with the engineering firm, Lennon Smith Souleret Engineering, Inc, are working for Delmont Borough performing smoke testing on the borough sanitary sewer system in on your street the week of: _____.

This testing of the sewer lines takes about 30 minutes to complete and we will locate connections, breaks and defects in the sewer system. The whitish smoke that you may see coming from vent stacks on homes or other structures or from holes in the ground is NON-TOXIC, HARMLESS, ODERLESS AND CREATES NO FIRE HAZARD. The smoke should not enter a home or other structure unless there are defects in the plumbing or empty drain traps in the building.

If the smoke associated with the testing enters your home or other structure, you should not be alarmed, but you should contact a member of the testing crew working near your home. They will be wearing flourescent vests and with the name Standard Pipe Services on them. They will be driving either white vans or trucks with similar markings. They will be pleased to assist you in any way they can.

To reduce the possibility that smoke will enter your home or other structure, you should pour water into seldom used floor drains or other plumbing fixtures in the basement of the building. If smoke from the testing enters your building you may simply open a window and let it vent outside.

This survey and other data collection activities will aid the borough in locating defects in the sanitary sewer system and are part of an effort to provide residents with improved sanitary sewer service. Your cooperation is important to a successful completion of the program.
